DISCUSSION ON WORKERS COMP POLICY FOR CITY EMPLOYEES

City Manager Greg Smith said this proposed policy would make up the gap between what worker comp pays and what employees earn. Mayor Pro tem Rob Gowin asked if this was an insurance policy. Mr. Smith said this is just an organizational policy by the city. Mr. Smith said it would have no impact financially on the city. Mr. Smith told council they would be seeing something on this soon.

DISCUSSION ON AMENDMENT TO CITY TOW TRUCK ORDINANCE

City Manager Greg Smith stated this was brought to his attention by a citizen who was towed by a on rotation tow company. Mr. Smith stated the city does not currently regulate tow truck rates. Mr. Smith asked council if they wanted to consider setting a maximum fee for on rotation wreckers. Councilman Tim McRae stated he is all for looking at regulating the rotational towing companies. Mr. Smith said that staff would review the entire rotation process and bring the information back to council.
