City Announces City Manager Resignation

The City of Jacksonville is announcing that City Manager, Greg Smith, has tendered his resignation of employment after accepting an offer for the City Manager position with the City of Denison, Texas.

City Council will take his resignation into review during a special, closed City Council meeting on Monday, June 28, 2021. The Council will announce an action plan in the days following the special meeting.

“When we hired Mr. Smith, we knew we needed to hire a person who could “right the ship”. He turned out to be just what Jacksonville needed. The priority of the Jacksonville City Council was getting Jacksonville moving towards a more positive and prosperous future and Mr. Smith has done a tremendous job making this happen.
